- One \$1,000.00 Scholarship will be awarded to an applicant with a 3.5 GPA or greater that shows school and community involvement, leadership, a good work ethic and demonstrates a desire to pursue higher education.
- One \$1,000.00 Scholarship will be awarded to an applicant with a 2.0 GPA or greater that shows school and community involvement and demonstrates a desire to pursue higher education. Consideration will be given to applicants with financial need.
- One \$1,000.00 Scholarship will be awarded to an applicant with a 3.0 GPA or greater that shows school and community involvement, leadership, a good work ethic and demonstrates a desire to pursue higher education in either career technical education or college/university.

- The scholarship award winners will receive their scholarship upon proof of enrollment in an institution of higher learning. The check will then be made payable to the institution.
